

THE 3905 CENTURY CLUB, INC.
CANADIAN CALL AREA (CANCA) AWARD APPLICATION
(MULTI-BAND, EACH MODE SEPERATELY)
(ENDORSTABLE)

This award is earned for contacts with Canadian provinces and/or territories on two bands using a single operating mode. It may be earned using each mode for which *The 3905 Century Club, Inc.* has nets.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. All contacts for this award must be made on *The 3905 Century Club, Inc.* nets.
2. Contacts must be made on two nets on two different bands, same mode, as specified on the application.
3. Applicants must hold a Club 100-Point Certificate for each of the bands/modes for which this application is submitted.
4. All QSL cards applied toward this award may have been used on prior awards other than the Canadian Call Area Award, and may be used on other Club awards that do not specifically restrict their use.
5. You may claim a call sign only once per province or territory. For the purpose of this award, a call sign modified by a special prefix, or by a mobile or portable designator, is the same call sign, unless it is in a different province or territory.
6. One (1) Super Wild Card (SWC) previously unused on any other award may be substituted for one of the following: Newfoundland-Labrador, Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Northwest Territories, Yukon or Nunavut. This substitution is permitted only **ONCE** across **ALL** Canadian Call Area applications (initial and any endorsements) using the same mode.

NOTE: Be very careful when using Super Wild Cards because an SWC may only be used once and only once. Once used, it cannot be used again anywhere on any other awards offered by *The 3905 Century Club*.

8. You may apply for an initial certificate award only once for each mode used by our Club nets; i.e., SSB, CW, RTTY, PSK. No mixed modes on any application - either phone only, CW only, RTTY only, or PSK only.
9. Within that one chosen mode, you must choose any two bands on which the Club has a net as the basis for your application for an initial certificate for that mode. Your initial certificate will be issued for completing the requirements for any one (1) Canadian Call Area for the mode and bands you selected. Endorsements for each of the other three (3) Canadian Call Areas must use the **same** mode and bands and may be applied for at the same time as the initial certificate.
10. All QSL cards previously applied toward awards may also be used toward this award.
11. The number of contacts required for each call area on each of the two chosen bands (referred to as Band 1 and Band 2) is indicated by the number of blanks (and by instructions) on the application form on page 3. Fill the required blanks in the call area(s) for which you are applying with valid contacts per the instructions on the form.

SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS:

1. After first assuring that each card used toward this award conforms to all of the requirements above, refer to the standard instructions contained in the application for the 100-Point Award, or on our web site (Awards Program, General Information), or included with this application if it was obtained by postal mail, for submitting applications and paying award fees.
