

THE 3905 CENTURY CLUB, INC.
EYEBALL WEEK AWARD APPLICATION

(ANY BANDS/MODES)
(NOT ENDORSABLE)

The Eyeball Week Award is earned for submitting QSL cards confirming contacts made between **basic call signs** used by operators who **are attending the Eyeball** and **basic call signs** used by operators who **are not attending the Eyeball**. Contacts made with or by Special Event or Club call signs are not valid toward this award. This award may be earned using any combination of bands/modes for which *The 3905 Century Club, Inc.* (Club) operates an awards net.

DEFINITIONS:

OPERATOR – The term "operator" refers to a person involved in a radio communication.

BASIC CALL SIGN – The call sign minus any modifiers – only the prefix, call area and suffix.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. All applicants for this award must hold a 100-Point Certificate on at least one of the nets run by The 3905 Century Club, Inc.
2. All contacts must be made on any of The 3905 Century Club, Inc. awards nets.
3. All contacts must be made during the period from 0000Z of the Friday before the Eyeball until 2359Z of the Saturday after the Eyeball, Zulu.
4. Only contacts between basic call signs used by operators who are attending the Eyeball and basic call signs used by operators who are not attending the Eyeball may be counted toward this award. Contacts between attendees don't count. Contacts between non-attendees don't count. You may **not** use contacts with Special Event or Club call signs toward this award.
5. All QSL cards for contacts applied toward this award may have been used on prior awards other than the Eyeball Week Award and may be used on other Club awards that do not specifically restrict their use.
6. Award applications must show the basic call sign contacted, band/mode, and points awarded for each contact.
7. Contacts listed on this application **must be sorted in order by band/mode, then call sign**.
8. All award applications must be submitted by the end of the calendar year in which the Eyeball occurs.
9. If questions about interpretation of the requirements for this award arise, and you can't reach agreement with your Area Awards Manager, please contact the Awards Committee whose decision on interpretation will be final unless overridden by the Board of Directors. The Awards Committee will contact all involved before rendering a decision.

SCORING:

1. For each contact with a basic callsign on SSB – 1 point.
2. For each contact with a basic call sign on each of the digital modes – 2 points.
3. For each contact with a basic call sign on CW – 3 points.
4. You may use each basic call sign only once per band/mode.
5. You may not use Special Event or Club call signs toward this award.

SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS:

1. After first assuring that each contact used toward this award conforms to all of the requirements above, refer to the standard instructions contained in the most recent version of the application for the 100-Point Award, the SWL Award, under Awards Program Basics on our Club web site, or included with this application if it was obtained by postal mail, for submitting applications and paying awards/endorsement fees.
2. Contacts listed on this application **must be sorted in order by band/mode, then call sign.**
