

THE 3905 CENTURY CLUB, INC.
ROAMING MASTER AWARD APPLICATION

(MIXED BAND/MODE)
(ENDORSTABLE)

The Roaming Master Award is earned for submitting QSL cards confirming contacts made by or with the same Master's Degree Award holder operating mobile or portable in multiple states, Canadian provinces/territories or DX entities. This award may combine contacts from all bands/modes for which *The 3905 Century Club, Inc.* (Club) operates an awards net.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. All applicants for this award must hold a 100-Point Certificate on any band/mode for which the Club operates an awards net.
2. The initial award is earned for contacts made by or with a single Master's Degree Award holder while he/she is operating mobile or portable in any combination of 12 different states, Canadian provinces/territories, or DX entities.
3. Endorsements are available for contacts made by or with that same Master's Degree Award holder in increments of nine (9) additional US States, Canadian Provinces or Territories or DX entities not previously used by or for that particular Master.
4. There are two versions of this award:
 - a. The Rover version of this award is earned for four (4) confirmed contacts made by a Master's Degree Award holder from each of twelve (12) different US States, Canadian Provinces or Territories, or DX entities – 48 cards required. Endorsements are available in increments of nine (9) additional US States, Canadian Provinces or Territories, or DX entities, four (4) confirmed contacts made from each.
 - b. The Tracker version of this award is earned for confirmed contacts made with a single Master's Degree Award holder located in twelve (12) different US States, Canadian Provinces or Territories, or DX entities – 12 cards required. Endorsements are available in increments of nine (9) US States, Canadian Provinces or Territories, or DX entities, one confirmed contact made with each.
5. The initial award involving a single Master, and subsequent endorsements to that initial award for contacts made by or with that same Master constitute a single Roaming Master award series. You may earn additional initial awards and subsequent endorsements using different Master's Degree Award holders, but each Roaming Master award series must consist of contacts made by or with only one Master's Degree Award holder.
6. All contacts must be made on Club awards nets and may be from any mixture of nets.
7. Only contacts made on or after July 1, 2012 are usable toward this award.
8. All contacts toward this award made by or with Masters must be made on or after the date their Master's Degree Award was granted.
9. The Master's Degree Award status must be preprinted on the QSL cards, or written on them by the Master worked. QSL cards must NOT be altered or augmented.
10. All QSL cards applied toward this award may have been used on prior awards other than the Roaming Master Award, and may be used on other Club awards that do not specifically restrict their use.
11. If questions about interpretation of the requirements for this award arise, and you can't reach agreement with your Area Awards Manager, please contact the Awards Committee whose

decision on interpretation will be final. The Awards Committee will contact all involved before rendering a decision.

SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS:

1. After first assuring that each card used toward this award conforms to all of the requirements above, refer to the standard instructions contained in the most recent version of the application for the 100-Point Award, the SWL Award, or on our Club web site (<http://www.3905ccn.com>, in the menu under Awards Program, General Information), or included with this application if it was obtained by postal mail, for submitting applications and paying awards/endorsement fees.
